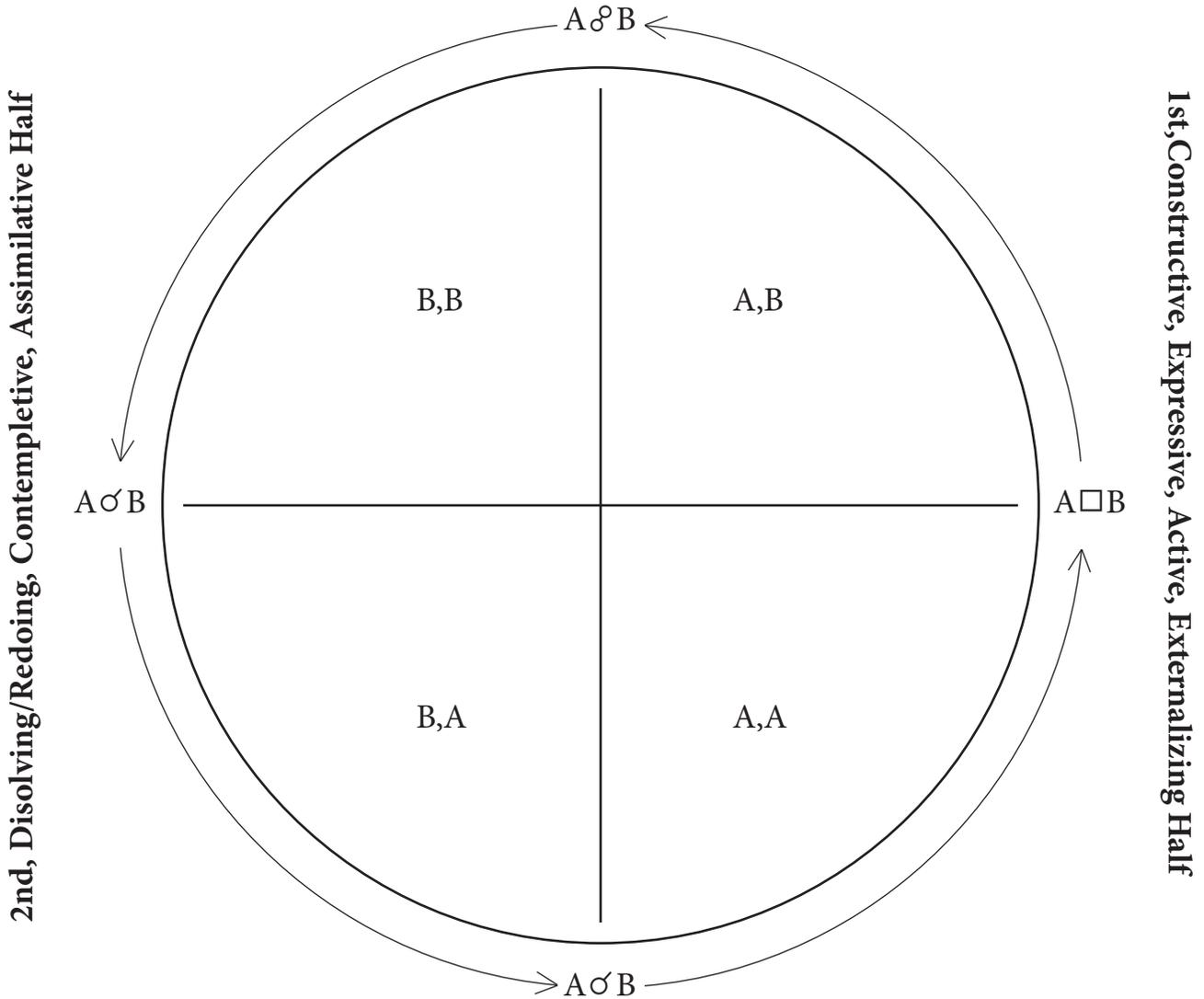


Sample Binary Cycle



“A” is the slower of two planets in a binary cycle, “B” the faster.

All work in a binary cycle is a composite of the work of the two planets.
For example the work of a Saturn-Jupiter cycle is work of judgement.

In the first half of the cycle “A” gives to “B” or “B” draws from “A”
In the second half of the cycle “B” gives to “A” or “A” draws from “B”

In the half of the cycle closest to the opposition “B” has a stronger influence.
In the half of the cycle closest to the conjunction “A” has a stronger influence.

“A” rules the first half of the cycle and “B” the second half.
Generally, not always, the slower planet dominates the cycle, e.g. the ☉ - ♃ cycle

In binary cycles between inner planets and outer planets the cycle is virtual or implied.
