Conditions which bode for success in the question

Strongest likelihood:

- 1) Application.
- 2) Translation of Light.
- 3) Collection of Light.
- 4) Reception.

Second order of likelihood:

- 5) Pseudo Collection or Translation.
- 6) Mutual depsition.
- 7) Any strong lunar aspect to a "prime".
- 8) Self deposition (especially of the planet indicating the querient).
- 9) Dignity (especially of the planet indicating the querient).

Third order of likelihood:

- 10) Harmonious or appropriate Moon phase.
- 11) Telegraphing (usually lunar).
- 12) Familiarity (classic term, listen to talk).
- 13) "Primes" in good relation to benefics.
- 14) Angulation or accidental dignity ("prime" or "primes").
- 15) Good aspect(s) to a "prime".
- 16) Benefic in or cusping a relevant house.
- 17) Strong benefic aspects to relevant cusps(usually house cusps).

Mild positives which could end up being sufficient, scale trippers in close calls:

18) Early or heart degrees of signs on relevant cusps.

- 19) Favorable polarities between primary angles (1st and 10th).
- 20) Elevation of Moon, prime, relevant benefic.
- 21) Pars Fortuna favorable (usually by aspect, preferably a "prime".)
- 22) Caput or Coda significant and favorable.
- 23) Very strong benefic aspect(s) between outsiders.
- 24) Good secondary partners (term from Arabic astrology, on recording).
- 25) Good, strong and relevant ruler of planetary hour.
- 26) "Prime" or secondary rising, i.e. in the east from nadir to midheaven.
- 27) "Prime" swift or increasing in light (table of average planetary speeds necessary).
- 28) "Bright" or increasing in light.
- 29) Increasing in declination or latitude.
